LGBT Medicine

DESCRIPTION

According to the most recent US census data, approximately 8% of the US population identifies within the LGBT population.¹ Further education within undergraduate medical education, graduate medical education, and continued medical education will help bridge health disparities and discrepancies.

OBJECTIVES & OUTCOMES

1. Evaluate the history of LGBT healthcare within US and the challenges of conducting research on the LGBT population.

2. Create a plan for discussing sexual orientation and gender identity within new patient encounters in the emergency department.
3. Review health status of gay population at different phases in life and evaluate how those are applicable within emergency medicine.
4. Review health status of lesbian population at different phases in life and evaluate how those are applicable within emergency medicine.
5. Review health status of transgender population at different phases in life and evaluate how those are applicable within emergency medicine.
