Opioid Use Disorder in the Emergency Department

DESCRIPTION

Opioid use disorder is common underlying reason for presentation to an Emergency Department and to reduce the number one cause of death for 18-44 years-old it is imperative that Emergency Physicians recognize OUD, stabilize OUD and refer to timely follow-up at an Office Based Opioid Treatment center (OBOT).
